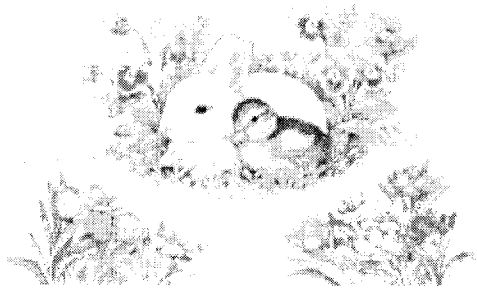

- ODOT has notified the Village that next year, 2008, State Highway 303 (Center Street) will receive preventative maintenance in the Village limits. Council will be required to pass legislation (provided by ODOT) during the April 17, 2007 Council Meeting.

- The Citgo Station name has been changed back to D & A Oil. The station will continue to be run by Donny Altieri and stay the same. Citgo will no longer be doing business in Ohio and other states.
- Meetings with the Army National Guard and Congressman Ryan's office to provide water and sewer utilities to the Arsenal continue. We have been seeking grants and loans from the Federal Government.
- A much needed face-lift for the Village Offices, Council Chambers, the Police Department, and maintenance building is happening. New roofing, siding, drainage repairs, interior repairs are in process.
- The Annual Fireman's (Fire Department) Carnival fundraiser will be held Thursday, May 31st thru Sunday, June 1st on the Village Grounds behind the Post Office and Fire Station.



- The Athletic Boosters will hold a Chinese Auction on Saturday May 6th at the WHS. Doors open at 10:00 auction begins at 3:00.
- Council's Safety Committee is forming a Joint Fire District Exploratory/Advisory Committee. Rachel Barrett, Phil Snyder, and Sonya Edwards who are the Safety Committee members have chosen Maurice Hankins to serve as the chairperson of the Joint Fire District Exploratory/ Advisory Committee. Maurice is a former Fireman, Assistant Fire Chief to Chief Don Miller and former Mayor. - **Parking Violation Enforcement:** As of April 16th thru April 30th 2007, the Village of Windham will enforce all Public Parking Violations on Public Village Streets, according to Municipal Code 303.08.

Failure to comply with proper parking and/or registration will result in non-moving citation and a summons to appear in court.
