SAFETY COMMITTEE

PRESENT: Mayor Jim Moore, Kevin Knight, Marian Garrett, Scott Garrett, Sonya Edwards, Lloyd Billman, Mark Manlove-Solicitor, Rachel Barrett, Tom(RC reporter, Clair Simpson, Jim Mitchell, Carol Hedge.

POLICE: Mayor Moore reported Chief DeSalvo is still on sick leave and has approx. eight weeks of unused sick leave left, therefore he has designated Sgt. Dale Korman as the Officer in Charge with Officer James Mitchell next in line; stated due to the financial condition of the Village it is going to be necessary to cut hours-- will met with Korman & Mitchell within the next forty-eight hours on the number of hours that will need to be cut; Officer Cox is back to work after being off about two weeks.

Scott commended the Officers for the great job in identifying the individuals allegedly responsible for the vandalism at Park.

Officer Mitchell requested authorizatiob to purchase a vest (\$500.00-\$550.00) for one Officer and have window repaired in cruiser (broken during a drug bust--approx.\$530-to \$540 at Colonial Autobody-G'V). Authorization approved for both with payment to be made from the Crime Prevention Fund.

FIRE: Chief Clair Simpson reported we have one more EMT (Tricia Peterson) to assist with calls; will contact person from Nelson, inquire on status since she is not responding to calls. Brief discussion on the trailer fire--as what could be done with the positioning of the trailers (to many in such a small area). Manlove said probably nothing because the current trailers would be under the "Grandfather Clause" but could possibly control placement of any others thur Zoning and/or Portage County Health Department regulations--Clair to check.

Kevin Knight asked if Police and Fire personnel could help oversee the intersections and driveways after he leaves at 3:00 p.m. until the Contractors leave to make sure they have not blocked anything when they leave for the night.
