RESOLUTION R-2008-12

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE FISCAL OFFICER OF THE VILLAGE OF WINDHAM TO MAKE THE FOLLOWING TRANSFER BETWEEN THE EAST CENTER STREET SEWER LINE FUND AND THE SEWER OPERATING FUND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Windham desires to have adequate monies in the E. Center Street Sewer Line Fund; and

WHEREAS, there was an expenditure of monies from the Sewer Operating Fund which was a proper expenditure for the E. Center Street Sewer Line Fund during calendar year 2007; and

WHEREAS, this matter is an emergency affecting the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village of Windham.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Windham, three-fourths or more of its elected members concur that:

<u>Section One:</u> During February 2008 the Village Fiscal Officer shall have the authority to make a one time transfer from the following fund:

From E. Center St. Sewer Line Fund (Fund 5701)

To Sewer Operating Fund (Fund 5201) in the amount of \$6,000.00.

<u>Section Two:</u> It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in and open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council, and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section Three:</u> This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary to preserve the public health, safety, morals and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Windham, Ohio and this Resolution shall go into full force and effect immediately upon its passage by three-fourths (3/4's) of the members of Council.
