

RESOLUTION R-2007-9

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND VILLAGE FISCAL OFFICER OF THE VILLAGE OF WINDHAM TO ENTER INTO A ONE (1) YEAR CONTRACT EFFECTIVE APRIL 1, 2007 WITH THOMAS BRETT TO BECOME A PART TIME EMPLOYEE AS THE VILLAGE'S RENTAL HOUSING MAINTENANCE INSPECTOR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Windham's Safety / Personnel / Rules Committee has recommended to the Village Council that Thomas Brett be hired as a part time employee to serve as the Village's Rental Housing Maintenance Inspector, and

WHEREAS, this matter is an emergency affecting the health, safety and welfare of the residence of the Village of Windham;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by Council of the Village of Windham, two-thirds or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

Section One: The Mayor and Village Fiscal Officer of the Village of Windham are hereby authorized to enter into a one (1) year contract with Thomas Brett to become a part time employee as the Village Rental Housing Maintenance Inspector.

Section Two: It is hereby determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public compliance with all legal requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section Three: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary to Preserve the public health, safety, morals and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Windham, Ohio and this Resolution shall go into full force and effect immediately upon its passage by two-thirds (2/3) of the members of Council.
