

RESOLUTION R-2007-44

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE FISCAL OFFICER OF THE VILLAGE OF WINDHAM TO ADVANCE \$1,186.64 FROM THE REVOLVING LOAN FUND TO STATE HIGHWAY FUND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village Council recognizes an excess of \$1,186.64 in its Revolving Loan Fund (Fund 2903) which can be used to assist the State Highway Fund (Fund 2021) which currently has a negative balance; and

WHEREAS, this matter is an emergency affecting the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village of Windham.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Windham, three-fourths or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

Section One: That the Village Fiscal Officer of the Village of Windham is hereby authorized to advance \$1,186.64 from the Revolving Loan Fund (Fund 2903) to the State Highway Fund (Fund 2021) and make repayments of \$98.89 per month until the balance is repaid..

Section Two: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council, and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section Three: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary in order to have adequate funds in the E. Center Street Sewer Project line item and this Resolution shall go into full force and effect immediately upon its passage by three-fourths (3/4's) of the members of Council.
