

**RESOLUTION R-2008-52**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE FISCAL OFFICER OF THE VILLAGE OF WINDHAM RETROACTIVELY TO JULY 24, 2008 TO CREATE A PURCHASE ORDER NUMBER 751-2008 TO SAL CHEMICAL IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5,550.02 FOR CHEMICALS FOR THE WATER PLANT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the Village of Windham desires to maintain the water plant; and

**WHEREAS**, there was a desire for an order to be placed and the cost of this order exceeded \$3000.00 which makes passage of this Resolution necessary for the Purchase Order to be created and the invoice to be paid; and

**WHEREAS**, this matter is an emergency affecting the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village of Windham.

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Windham, three-fourths or more of its elected members concur that:

Section One: The Village Fiscal Officer shall have the authority to create a purchase order number 751-2008 in the amount of \$5,550.02 to Sal Chemical Company retroactively to July 24, 2008 for chemicals for the water plant.

Section Two: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council, and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section Three: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary to preserve the public health, safety, morals and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Windham, Ohio and this Resolution shall go into full force and effect immediately upon its passage by three-fourths (3/4's) of the members of Council.
