- Retain Glenwood Barker as Street Commissioner at \$200 per year. I. (Resolution needed)
- II. Retain Ronald J Kane as Village Solicitor at same rate of pay. (Resolution needed)
- III. Everybody take a real good look at finances, as due to the ecomony, we cannot expect the 1983 income to be above that of 1982. "On December 31, 1981 we had a carryover of \$53,000"
 - "In 1982 our income was \$256,000 plus the carryover of \$53,000 for a total of \$309,000"

"Our proposed Budget for 1983 is \$307,000"

"Adding \$256,000 and \$25,000 together is only \$281,000" "Almost half of our income-\$145,000-was from the Income Tax"

- TV. A sewer rate increase of \$.50 a month should be enacted to keep up with growing utility costs to run the plant.
- V. Give NO credit to people paying Income Tax in other cities, like the rest of Ohio cities and villages are now doing.
- VI. Place on the ballott this fall: Increasing the Income Tax to 1.5%for General Fund and Capital Improvements.
