RESOLUTION NO. R-2009-34

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT BETWEEN THE
VILLAGE OF WINDHAM AND CINTAS FOR SERVICE DEPARTMENT UNIFORM
WORK PANTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Windham has determined to cut operation costs by reducing the amount to be paid to an outside service for work uniforms for employees of the Service and Utility Departments; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Windham has previously entered into an agreement with Cintas for employee uniforms under which agreement the typical weekly cost ranged between \$60.51 and \$73.35; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Windham Solicitor has negotiated a new contract between the Village of Windham and Cintas which provides for uniform work pants for the employees of the Service and Utility Departments at a cost of \$16.70 per week.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Windham, two thirds of the members thereto elected concurring that:

Section 1: The actions of the Windham Village Solicitor in negotiating the Contract attached to this Resolution as Exhibit "A" are hereby confirmed and ratified.

Section 2: The Contract between the Village of Windham and Cintas, in substantial conformity with the Exhibit attached hereto, and marked for identification as Exhibit "A", is hereby approved, and the Mayor and the Fiscal Officer are authorized and directed to execute the Contract on behalf of the Village of Windham.

Section 3: The Fiscal Officer of the Village of Windham is hereby directed to pay the amounts due to Cintas under Exhibit "A", as the agreement is effective as of June 25, 2009 and no payment of any nature has been made by the Village to Cintas since June 25, 2009.

Section 4: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure, necessary to preserve the public health, safety, morals and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Windham, Ohio, and for the further reason that the savings to the Village under the attached Exhibit "A" should be realized as soon as possible.

Section 5: It is hereby found and determined that all actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Passed in Council as an emergency this the 27th day of October, 2009.
