

ORDINANCE NO. O-2009-40

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 155.05(a) OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF WINDHAM TO REVISE THE DATES OF HOLIDAYS FOR VILLAGE OF WINDHAM EMPLOYEES, AND REPEALING ALL PRIOR AND INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Section 155.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Windham establishes the dates of holidays for Village of Windham employees; and

WHEREAS, employees of the Village of Windham have requested an adjustment in the days established by the Village as holidays; and

WHEREAS, the Personnel Committee of the Village of Windham has investigated the employee's request for an adjustment as to when the holidays are scheduled, and has concluded that essential services provided by the Village to the citizens will not be compromised by granting the requested adjustment.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Windham, a two thirds or more of the members elected concurring:

SECTION 1: Section 155.05(a) HOLIDAYS; HOLIDAY PAY as it is presently enacted by the Village of Windham is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2: The following Section 155.05(a) is hereby enacted:

155.05 HOLIDAYS; HOLIDAY PAY.

(a) The following days are recognized as holidays for the employees of the Village of Windham: the first day of January (New Year's Day), the third Monday in January (Martin Luther King Day), the last Monday in May (Memorial Day), the fourth of July (Independence Day), the first Monday in September (Labor Day), the second Monday in October (Columbus Day), the fourth Thursday in November (Thanksgiving), the fourth Friday in November, the twenty-fourth day of December (Christmas Eve), and the twenty-fifth day of December (Christmas).

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure, effective immediately upon its passage by Council and approved by the Mayor, in order to preserve the health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the Village of Windham, and for the further reason it is necessary to adjust the scheduled holidays for Village employees in advance of the 2010 calendar year.

SECTION 4: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were accepted in an open meeting of this Council, and that deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meeting open to the public, in compliance with Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
