

**ORDINANCE NO. O-2009-17**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF A 2000 FORD CROWN VICTORIA OWNED BY THE VILLAGE AND NO LONGER NEEDED FOR ANY MUNICIPAL PURPOSE.**

**WHEREAS,** Ohio Revised Code 721.15 authorizes municipalities to sell personal property no longer needed for municipal purposes; and

**WHEREAS,** Chief Edward Perdian of the Village of Windham Police Department has determined that the 2000 Ford Crown Victoria, formerly known as Unit No. 3, is no longer needed by the Windham Police Department; and

**WHEREAS,** the Council of the Village of Windham has determined that the 2000 Ford Crown Victoria is no longer needed for any municipal purpose.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Windham, Portage County, Ohio a majority or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

**SECTION 1:** The Council authorizes the advertisement, for sale, of the 2000 Ford Crown Victoria automobile for not less than two (2) nor more than four (4) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the municipal corporation and hereby ratifies all actions which may already have been taken in conformity with this direction.

**SECTION 2:** The Council authorizes the sale of the 2000 Ford Crown Victoria to the highest bidder, but subject to a reserve sale amount, which amount has been relayed to Chief Perdian.

**SECTION 3:** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were accepted in an open meeting of this Council, and that deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meeting open to the public, in compliance with Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
