ORDINANCE 0-2019-2

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE NUMBERING FOR THE AUTOMATED SPEED ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM CHAPTER ESTBLISHED BY ORDINANCE 2018-22 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village Council enacted Ordinance 2018-22 on October 23, 2018 to establish an Automated Speed Enforcement Program; and

WHEREAS, upon review, an error in the numbering of the code sections of the legislation has been located; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that the establishment of the requirements enacted in Ordinance 2018-22 is a matter of public safety and desires to correct the numbering errors as soon as possible.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Windham, County of Portage, State of Ohio, two thirds or more of the me members thereto concurring that:

<u>Section One</u>: The Automated Speed Enforcement Program as enacted by the Windham Codified Ordinances initially contained contradictory references to chapter and section numbers, specifically some chapter and section references are to 307 in some instances and to 315 in others.

<u>Section Two</u>: The Automated Speed Enforcement Program Chapter is hereby renumbered as needed to establish that all chapter and section number references are to Chapter 315.

<u>Section Three</u>: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, immediately effective upon passage by at least two-thirds of the members elected to the Windham Village Council, in order for the numbering to be corrected and as a result the legislation will be in full force and effect now, as a matter of establishing and preserving public safety within the Village.

<u>Section Four:</u> It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council, and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
