ORDINANCE NO. O-2014-5

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WINDHAM VILLAGE ZONING ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE COMPENSATION OF THE ZONING INSPECTOR

Whereas, the Mayor and the Planning Commission have recommended that the zoning code be amended with respect to the compensation to be paid to the Village of Windham Zoning Inspector; and

Whereas, in accordance with Windham Codified Ordinance Section 1147.01 the Council on January 28, 2014, by resolution fixed the time, date and place of the public hearing on the proposed amendment and directed the Village Fiscal Officer to publish the notice described in Windham Codified Ordinance Section 1147.01; and

Whereas, the Council caused notice of the proposed amendment and the time and place of the public hearing to be published in the Record Courier, a paper of general circulation in the Village, once a week for three successive weeks; and

Whereas, on March 25, 2014 at least thirty days after the date of the first publication of the notice in the Record Courier, the Council held a public hearing on the proposed amendment; and

Whereas, he Council has considered the recommendation of the Mayor and the Planning Commission and after the public hearing desires to amend the Zoning Code as recommended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Windham, Portage County, Ohio, the majority or more of its members thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: That section 1139.01(c) as it is presently enacted is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2: That a new Section 1139.01(c) as follows is hereby enacted: "(c) The compensation for the Zoning Inspector shall be as established by the Mayor and subject to the advice and confirmation of the Village Council."

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were accepted in an open meeting of this Council, and that deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meeting open to the public, in compliance with Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>SECTION 4</u>: That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
