

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING VARIOUS SECTIONS OF THE VILLAGE OF WINDHAM
CRIMINAL CODE WITH RESPECT TO THE PENALTIES FOR VARIOUS DRUG
RELATED OFFENSES**

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Windham has identified the need for and proposes an adjustment to the penalties for various offenses charged under the Village of Windham Criminal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Safety Committee of the Village Council has recommended the changes set forth herein.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Windham, State of Ohio, the majority of the members thereto concurring that:

Section 1: That the following sections of the Village of Windham Criminal Code are hereby repealed: Section 513.03(d); 513.04(d); 513.05(d) and 513.07(c).

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were accepted in an open meeting of this Council, and that deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
