

**ORDINANCE NO. 0-2008-13**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 155.05 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF WINDHAM TO ADD MARTIN LUTHER KING JR DAY AS A PAID HOLIDAY FOR VILLAGE EMPLOYEES RETROACTIVE TO JANUARY 1, 2000 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND REPEALING ALL PRIOR INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES.

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Windham has allowed its employees a paid holiday for Martin Luther King Jr Day even though it was not official by listing in the Ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, this matter is an emergency measure affecting the health, safety and general welfare of the residence of the Village of Windham;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Windham three-fourths or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

**Section 1:** That Section 155.05 of the Codified Ordinance of the Village of Windham is hereby amended to add Martin Luther King Jr Day as a paid holiday retroactive to January 1, 2000.

**Section 2:** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were accepted in an open meeting of this Council, and that deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meeting open to the public, in compliance with Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**Section 3:** This Ordinance be declared an emergency measure and become effective upon its passage by Council and approved by the Mayor, and to further insure the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Windham.
