WHEREAS, upon consideration of the recommended changes, the Council of the Village of Windham has determined that the utility code of the Village should be amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Windham, Portage County and State of Ohio, two thirds or more of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1. Section 923.03(a) as it is presently enacted is hereby repealed effective

June 30, 2011.

SECTION 2. Section 923.03(a) of the Village of Windham Utility Code as is set forth in the attached Exhibit "A" is hereby enacted effective July 1, 2011.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were accepted in an open meeting of this Council, and that deliberations of this Council and any of its committees

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure needed to maintain the financial stability of the Village Utility Department, effective immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor, for the reason that it is necessary to have the adjusted rates in place at the beginning of a billing cycle beginning on July 1,

2011.
