

RESOLUTION R-2018-24

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A REVISION TO THE WINDHAM FACILITIES PLANNING AREA 208 PLAN AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Tia L. Rutledge, Planning Division Manager of the Portage County Water Resources Department has requested approval of a proposed revision to the Windham Facilities Planning Area Plan; and

WHEREAS, the proposed changes increase the area of Windham responsibility into the area known as the Ravenna Arsenal, which is a positive change anticipated by the Village for some time; and

WHEREAS, after consideration the Council has determined the Village should respond to the Portage County Water Resources Department indicating no objection to the proposed change.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Windham, State of Ohio, two thirds or more of the members thereto concurring that:

Section 1: That the proposed changes to the Windham Facilities Planning Area Plan which are set forth in the attached Exhibit A are approved.

Section 2: That the Village Administrator is directed to respond the proposed changes by indicating No Objection to the proposed revision.

Section 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were accepted in an open meeting of this Council, and that deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, becoming effective immediately on passage by Council and approval by the Mayor, as the inquiry was received by the Village on or about August 16, 2018 and the courtesy of a response is requested by August 31, 2018.

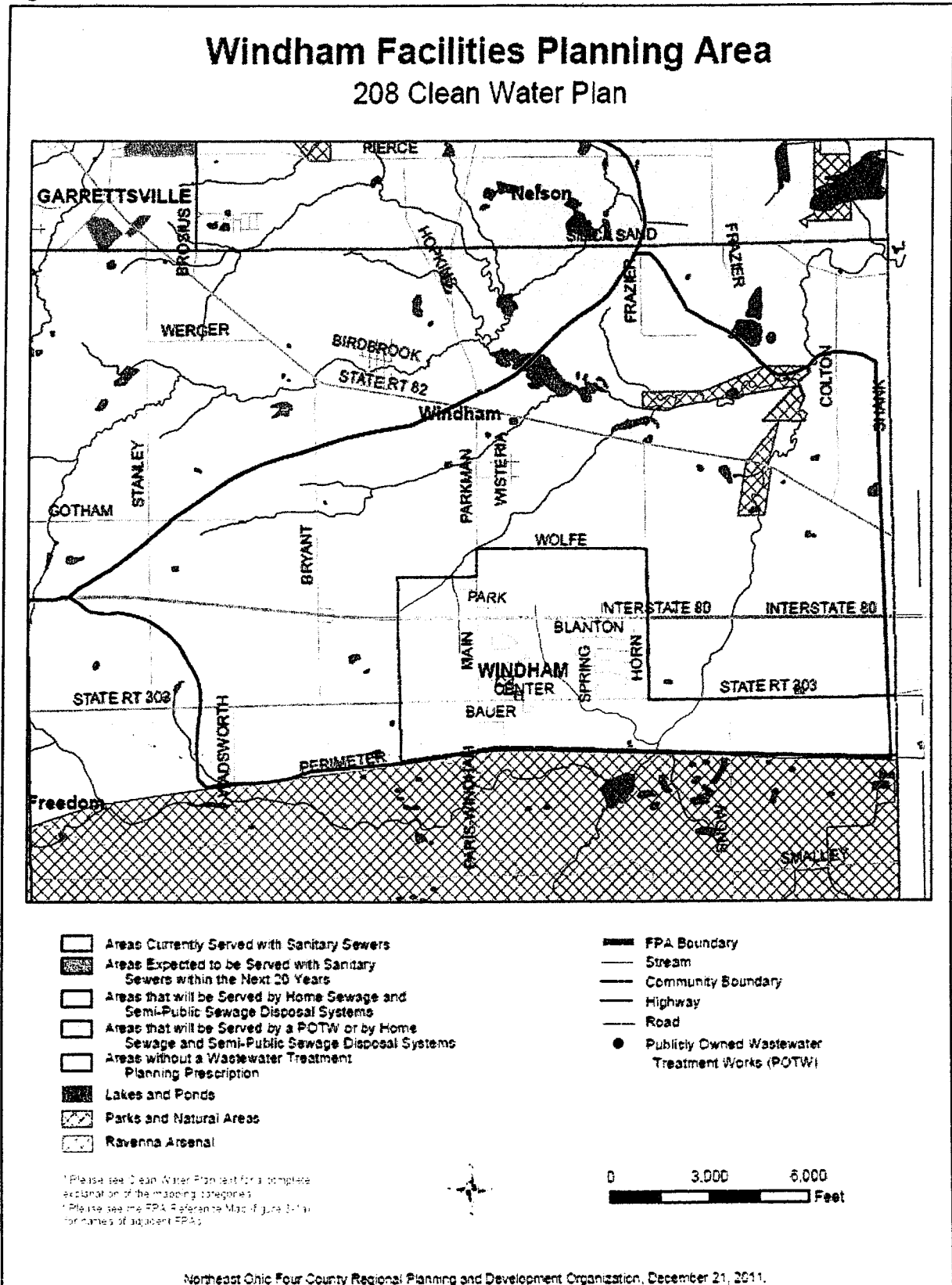
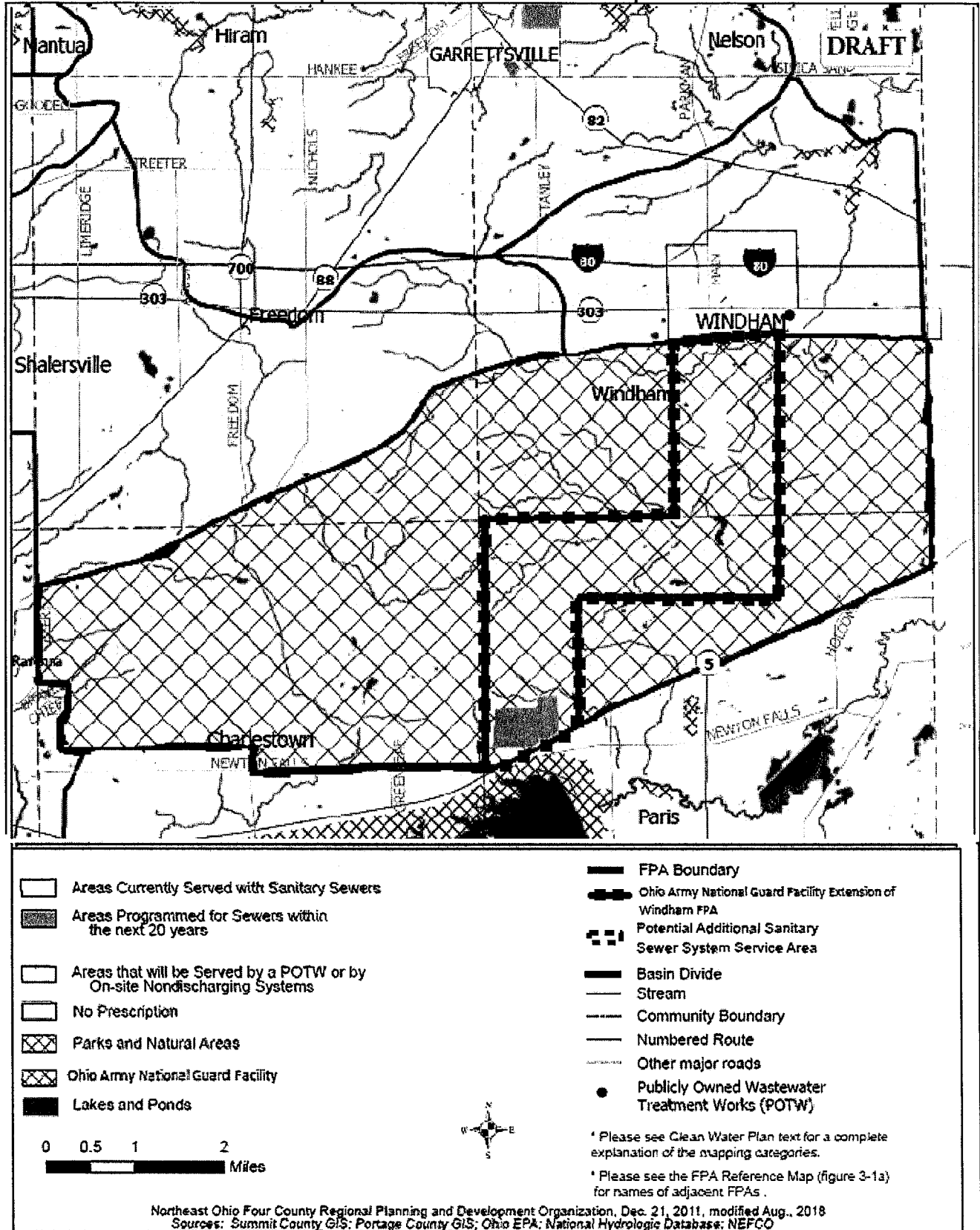


Figure 2 - 208 Clean Water Plan Amendment

I. Population Served:

The population projections used in the 201 Plan and those in the NEFCO 208 Clean Water Plan are compared below.

The above population projections (Approved 208) were prepared in 1990. Updated projections are scheduled to be prepared after county population projections are produced by the Ohio Department of Development Office of Strategic Research.

II. Wastewater Treatment Planning Prescription and Wastewater Planning Options

Original source information provided by the Portage County Water Resources Department (Portage County Regional Sewer District), June 30, 2000, and Village of Garrettsville, May 8, 2002.

Areas without wastewater treatment prescriptions (white):

These areas currently lack wastewater treatment prescriptions. Future wastewater treatment options will be determined by documented impacts to water resources and “best science” which is defined as the regulatory standards as set by current State and Federal regulations.

Portage County Water Resources Department (Portage County Regional Sewer District) Jurisdictions

Areas Currently Sewered (yellow):

Freedom, Windham, Hiram, and Nelson Townships - These areas are currently served with sanitary sewers that have been constructed and are currently in operation. However, there may be undeveloped tracts of land and vacant lots subject to improvement. All new development and construction in the yellow areas of this facilities planning area will be required to connect to and/or provide sanitary service to ensure that wastewater will be treated at an existing publicly-owned treatment works (POTW) with modifications or expansions as required to handle the flow. Existing non-residential private treatment systems (semi-public), shall be abandoned and connection made to the existing sanitary sewer system if available. Failing HSTSs serving single family homes shall be abandoned in accordance with Ohio Administrative Code 3701-29-02.

Areas That Will be Served by a POTW or by On-site Non-discharging Systems (green):

Freedom, Windham, Hiram, and Nelson Townships - Future development will be served by an existing POTW modified or expanded as required to handle the flow or a non-discharging sewage disposal system. Non-discharging systems including on-site septic

systems and systems in which the effluent is applied to the land are locally permitted at this time. New discharging systems are only permitted for repair of existing systems in cases where both central sewer and non-discharging systems are not available.

Areas Currently Programmed To Be Sewered (orange):

Freedom, Windham, Hiram, and Nelson Townships - These areas are proposed to be served with sanitary sewers. However, there may be undeveloped tracts of land and vacant lots subject to improvement. All new development and construction in the yellow areas of this facilities planning area will be required to connect to and/or provide sanitary service to ensure that wastewater will be treated at an existing publicly-owned treatment works (POTW) with modifications or expansions as required to handle the flow. Existing non-residential private treatment systems (semi-public), which cease to operate properly, shall be abandoned and connection made to the existing sanitary sewer system. Failing HSTSSs serving single family homes shall be abandoned in accordance with Ohio Administrative Code 3701-29-02.

Ohio Army National Guard Easements to Portage County Water Resources Department for Operational Jurisdictions

Ohio Army National Guard (purple line interior purple cross hatch):

This area is currently not served with sanitary sewers. The future of this area will be determined as future land use is identified.

Area Ohio Army National Guard Extension of Windham Facilities Planning Area (purple/red dashed line interior purple cross hatch):

A portion of this area is currently not served with sanitary sewers and are defined as areas where connection of facilities to sanitary sewer contained therein may occur for which for which future easements will be granted to Portage County Water Resources for operational jurisdiction. The future of this area will be determined as future land use is identified.

A portion of this area is where Portage County Water Resources has operational jurisdiction where sanitary sewers exist within easements granted to Portage County Board of Commissioners.
