

**ORDINANCE O-2017-5**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH A.P. O'HORO COMPANY FOR THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT IMPROVEMENT PROJECT WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF WINDHAM, PORTAGE COUNTY, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the Village of Windham has previously authorized the expenditure for the Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvements of the Village of Windham by Resolution R-2016-30, passed on September 27, 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, advertisements were made in the Record Courier, a news paper of general circulation within the Village of Windham, on January 27, 2017 and February 3, 2017, that sealed bids for the Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvement Project would be received at the Village Administrator's office within the Village of Windham until February 10th, 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, sealed bids were received by the Village of Windham from four different contractors; and

**WHEREAS**, the sealed bid from A.P. O'Horo Company in the amount of Seven Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars & 00/100 (\$710,000.00) is the lowest bid that has been received; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Project Manager has checked the references of A.P. O'Horo Company, and has found that the references demonstrate that A.P. O'Horo Company to be a responsible and responsive company, capable of performing under the contract if the contract is awarded to them; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Administrator and the Project Manager have recommended that A.P. O'Horo Company has submitted the lowest responsive and responsible bid and that the Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvement Project contract be awarded to A.P. O'Horo Company.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Windham, State of Ohio, two thirds or more of the members thereto concurring that:

**Section 1:** That the recommendation of the Village Administrator and the Project Manager are hereby accepted.

**Section 2:** That the bid submitted by A.P. O'Horo Company is declared to be the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

**Section 3:** That a contract, in substantial conformity with that attached hereto and marked for identification as Exhibit "A" between A.P. O'Horo Company and the Village of Windham, is hereby authorized. The Mayor and the Fiscal Officer are directed to execute said contract.

**Section 4:** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were accepted in an open meeting of this Council, and that deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**Section 5:** This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, becoming effective immediately on passage by Council and approval by the Mayor, in order to advance the health, safety and general welfare of the Village of Windham, and for the further reason that it is necessary to begin the Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvements Project in the Village of Windham at the earliest possible time.
