

**RESOLUTION R-2020-20**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF THE 1995 FORD MODEL F-80 TRUCK.**

**WHEREAS**, the Village Administrator has informed the Village Committee of the Whole that the 1995 Ford F-80 dump truck owned by the Village has rusted to the extent that it is unsafe and no longer economically feasible to repair; and

**WHEREAS**, as a result the Village Council has determined that it is no longer appropriate to own the 1995 Ford F-80 dump truck.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Village of Windham, Portage County, State of Ohio, two thirds (2/3) or more of the members thereto concurring that:

**SECTION 1:** The Council finds that the condition of the 1995 Ford F-80 dump truck is such that the vehicle is unreliable. The specific problem is the vehicle is so rusty as to be unsafe and unreliable and as a result the truck is no longer needed for any municipal purpose as that term is used in Ohio Revised Code 721.15.

**SECTION 2:** The Village Administrator is authorized to disassemble and sell in pieces (part out) the 1995 Ford F-80 dump truck. This direction is because the low mileage engine from the truck is more valuable than the entirety of the truck and because this Council does not want to sell a vehicle that it knows to be unsafe.

**SECTION 3** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were accepted in an open meeting of this Council, and that deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meeting open to the public, in compliance with Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


