ORDINANCE NO. O-2009-11

AN ORDINANCE REVISING SECTION 181.10 OF THE WINDHAM CONDIFIED ORDINANCES WITH RESPECT TO THE TIME FOR PAYMENT OF ESTIMATED TAXES TO THE VILLAGE OF WINDHAM.

WHEREAS, The Council of the Village of Windham has been advised that a discrepancy exists with respect to the time for the payment of quarterly estimated income tax to the Village of Windham, as is set presently set forth in Chapter 181.10, and the time for payment required by the United States Internal Revenue Service and the Ohio Department of Taxation; and

WHEREAS, The Council of the Village of Windham has determined that it is appropriate to adjust the time for estimated income tax payments to the Village of Windham so that Windham payments coincide with or are after the time for estimated tax payments established by the United States Internal Revenue Service and the Ohio Department of Taxation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Windham, Portage County, Ohio the majority of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: Windham Codified Ordinance 181.10(d)(1) as it is presently enacted is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2: The Village of Windham hereby enacts Section 181.010(d)(1) setting forth the time for quarterly payment of estimated income tax as is set forth in the attached Exhibit "A".

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were accepted in an open meeting of this Council, and that deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meeting open to the public, in compliance with Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

(d) (1) The estimated tax which is reported in a declaration of estimated tax shall be paid in full with the declaration or in equal installments on or before the last day of the fourth (4th), sixth (6th), ninth (9th) and thirteenth (13th) month after the beginning of the taxable year in question.
