

ORDINANCE O-2017-9

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 1409 AND SECTION 139.05 OF THE WINDHAM CODIFIED ORDINANCES.

WHEREAS, over an extended period of time the Police Chief has drafted Windham Police Department Rules and Regulations which, along with the provisions of the Village of Windham Employee Manual, govern the actions and behavior of members of the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Village Solicitor has reviewed and approved, as needed, revisions the Windham Police Department Rules and Regulations; and

WHEREAS, as a result the prior action of the Village Council in enacting Ordinance 1409 and Section 139.05 of the Windham Codified Ordinances to enact Standard Operating Procedures for the Police Department are not in conformity with current laws and should be repealed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Windham, County of Portage, State of Ohio that the majority of its members thereto concurring that:

Section One: Ordinance 1409 enacted on March 14, 1995 and Section 139.05 of the Windham Codified Ordinances is hereby repealed.

Section Two: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council, and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
