**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE PAY FOR SCHOOL CROSSING GUARDS AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the minimum wage for the State of Ohio is increased effective January 1, 2011;
and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Village of Windham, desire to comply with the
minimum wage of the State of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Windham had passed Resolution R-2010-44
which was an agreement between the Village of Windham and the Windham Exempted Village
School District providing for a School Resource Officer and Crossing Guards; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Windham desires to set the hourly rate for crossing
guards for the fiscal year 2011.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Windham, two
thirds of the members thereto elected concurring that:

Section 1: The salary for crossing guards for the Village of Windham is hereby
established as \$7.40 per hour effective January 1, 2011 until revised or amended by further action of
this Council.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all actions of this Council concerning
and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and
that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions
were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section
121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code

Section 3: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure, effective
immediately upon passage and signature by the Mayor, in order to preserve the health, safety and
welfare of the municipality and to provide for the terms of compensation for the crossing guards.
