

**ORDINANCE O-2018-15**

**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE RECODIFICATION,  
EDITING AND INCLUSION OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES AS PARTS OF  
THE VARIOUS COMPONENT CODES OF THE CODIFIED  
ORDINANCES OF WINDHAM, OHIO**

WHEREAS, various ordinances of a general and permanent nature have been passed which should be included in the Codified Ordinances of Windham, Ohio;

WHEREAS, numerous sections in the Traffic and General Offenses Codes need to be amended or enacted so as to conform to State law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WINDHAM, OHIO:

Section 1. That the recodification, editing, arrangement and numbering or renumbering of the following ordinances and parts of ordinances are hereby approved as parts of the various component codes of the Codified Ordinances of Windham, Ohio, so as to conform to the classification and numbering system of the Codified Ordinances, to-wit:
