

ORDINANCE O-2007- 20

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT ANTICIPATED REVENUE AND APPROPRIATIONS FOR 2007 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the E. Center Street Sewer Line budget needs increased to cover the costs associated with completing this project; and

WHEREAS, the OWDA funds to complete this project have not been appropriated for in the 2007 permanent appropriations.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Windham, Portage County, Ohio, with at least two-thirds of the members thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: The E. Center Street Sewer Line appropriations currently are \$836,668.70 and need to be increased to \$879,000.00 because this is the amount of the funds that will be spent in 2007.

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure becoming immediately effective upon passage by Council and approval by the Mayor because it will enable the completion of the East Center Street Sewer Project ensuring the welfare of the citizens of the Village of Windham, Ohio, and to further insure the effective operation of the village.

SECTION 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including §121.22 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio.
